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## "Social Entrepreneurship for Arts" Project

The "Social Entrepreneurship for Arts" (SE4A) project is financed by the European Commission through the Erasmus+ program under the Cooperation Partnerships for Vocational Education and Training, 2021 Call for proposals. The SE4A Project consortium partners come from six EU countries - Germany, Italy, Greece, Ireland, Bulgaria and Cyprus.

The overarching aim of the project is to strengthen the capacity of young professional artists and graduates in arts and humanities to develop and sustain social enterprises, mobilizing arts to create social change towards a better Europe for all. A digital training and mentorship program will sustain the aim and involve more than 300 participants.

### What happened up to now
